## Joan Miro was born in Barcelona in 1893.






The chiropodist

Miro started to paint when he was 8. His work was very simple.

In Paris Miro met famous painters and artists such as Pablo Picasso.






Morning star




In 1959 he went to live in Majorca.


2. Crayons




3. A black marker




4. Tissue paper





**Step 1:** Color your project with the following colors:

1. Color the	
background	
dark blue.	
2. Color the big	
triangle and the	
big oval yellow.	
3. Color the	
trapezoid light	
blue.	
4. Color the big	
circle red.	





**Step 2:** Use tissue paper to blend the colors.

Create secondary colors by blending two primary colors.





Step 3: Use a black marker to add different shapes and lines to your drawing.
