
Piet Mondrian

1872 TO 1944






Piet Mondrian was a very interesting artist. He was born in the Netherlands in 1872.




Mondrian in his Paris studio in 1933.

Mondrian created more than 250 paintings during his life. He became famous for his abstract paintings.

In his abstract paintings, he used colors, shapes and lines.



In many of his famous abstract paintings, Mondrian only used 5 colors: black, W and the primary colors red, yellow and blue.



Composition with Red, Yellow, Blue, and Black, 1921

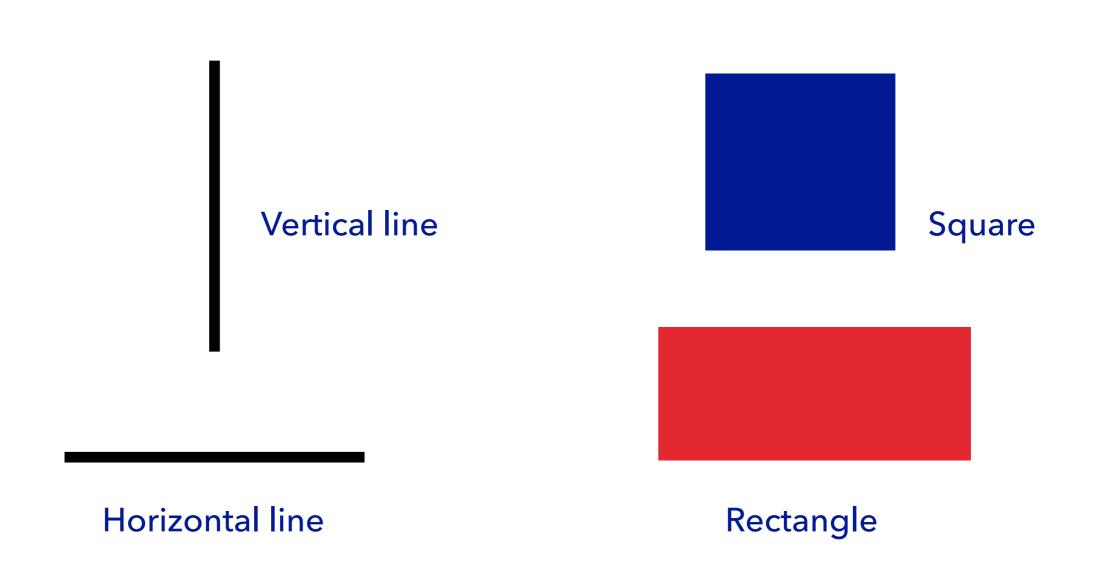


Primary colors are the most basic ones.

They cannot be made from mixing any other colors.

Primary colors can be mixed to make any other color.

Mondrian also used lines and shapes in his art.




The influence of Mondrian can be seen today in lots of things – from furniture to fashion!



Materials



1. White paper



2. Masking tape




3. Crayons




4. A black marker



Steps




1. On a piece of white paper, use masking tape to create shapes.



2. Color the shapes with the primary colors.




3. Trace the edges of the tape with a black marker.



4. Carefully peel of the tape to reveal the lines and shapes.

Materials



1. White paper




2. A black crayon




3. Crayons: red, yellow and blue



Steps




1. On a piece of white paper, make shapes using a black crayon.



2. Go over the black lines with the crayon to make them dark.



3. Color the shapes with the primary colors.



4. Remember to leave some white shapes.
