

Born: In Buenos Aires (Argentina) in 1910

Died: In A Coruña, in 1979

Professions: Painter, muralist, playwright, poet, cartoonist, designer, illustrator, publisher, lawyer...

Famous paintings:

Emigrante, 1967 As mariscadoras, 1969 Mar de Orzán, 1973 Figura de Muller, 1979

Style:

He mixed the Galician tradition (popular art, medieval art) and the new art movements (Cubism, Expressionism, etc.)

First, he paints shapes with bright colors. Afterwards, he adds lines and form.

Most of his paintings represent daily life in Galicia.

Artists who inspired him: Matisse, Paul Klee, Castelao, Carlos Maside, Colmeiro, Picasso...

He used to participate in gatherings at the Café Derby with his contemporaries: other artists and intellectuals of the 1930s.
