## An Amazing Life

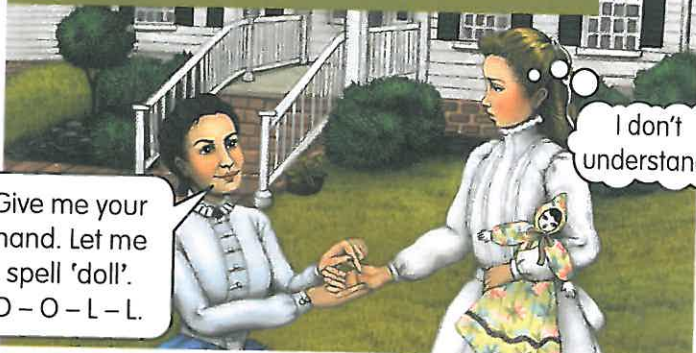
1 Helen Keller was born in 1880 in Alabama, in the USA. When she was a baby she was very ill. After the illness, Helen was deaf and blind.
