(Was → era/estaba) → PAST SIMPLE "TO BE"




1 Helen Keller was born in 1880 in Alabama, in the USA. When she was a baby she was very ill. After the illness, Helen was deaf and blind.




2 Helen wasn't very happy when she was a little girl. She was often angry.

5 At school Helen was the only deaf and blind girl. She was an intelligent girl and Anne was always there to help her learn.




6 In 1904, Helen was the first deaf and blind person to get a degree from university.




7 Later, Helen was a writer. The name of her first book was 'The Story of My Life'.
