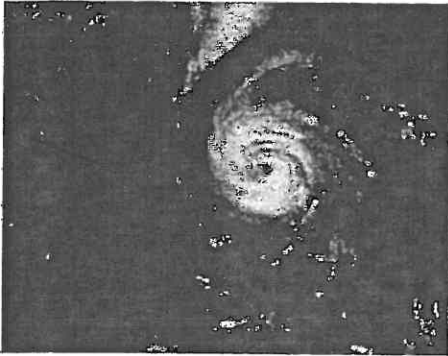

## Hurricanes!

### What is a hurricane?

A hurricane is a huge storm with strong winds and heavy rain. The centre of the storm is 'the eye' and it is the calmest part of the hurricane: it has only light winds. When hurricanes come to land, the heavy rain and strong winds can damage buildings, trees and cars.

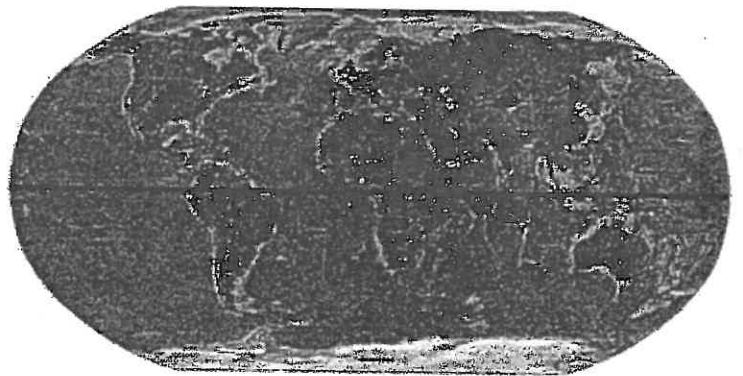
### Hurricanes have different names in different places.

- They call them 'hurricanes' in North America and the Caribbean.
- They call them 'cyclones' in the Indian Ocean.
- They call them 'typhoons' in Southeast Asia.

### Where and when do hurricanes form?

Hurricanes form over warm waters near the equator. This is because there is a lot of warm water in these areas to allow the storms to form.

Hurricanes in the Caribbean and the Atlantic Ocean occur between June 1<sup>st</sup> and November 30<sup>th</sup> each year. This is the hurricane season.

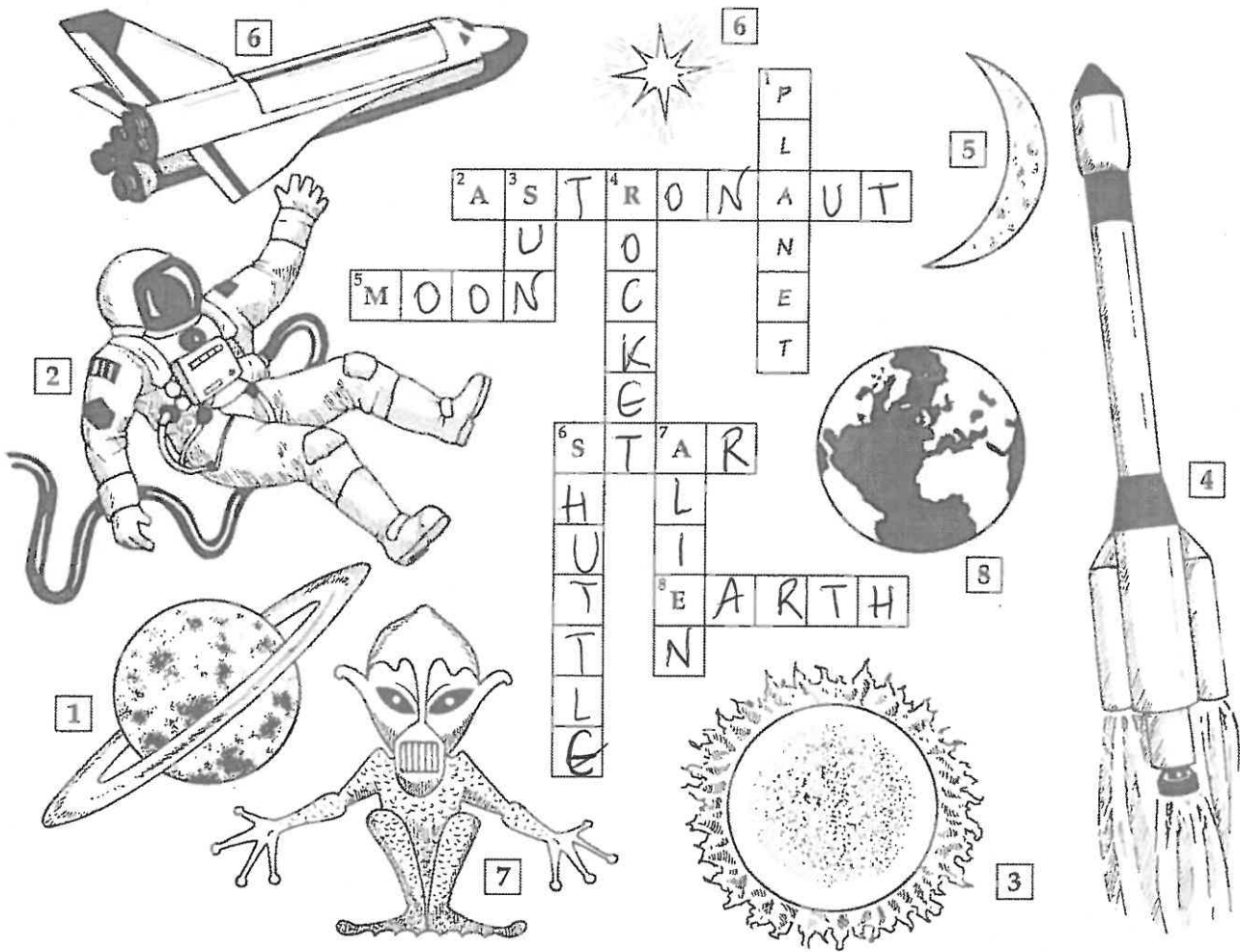

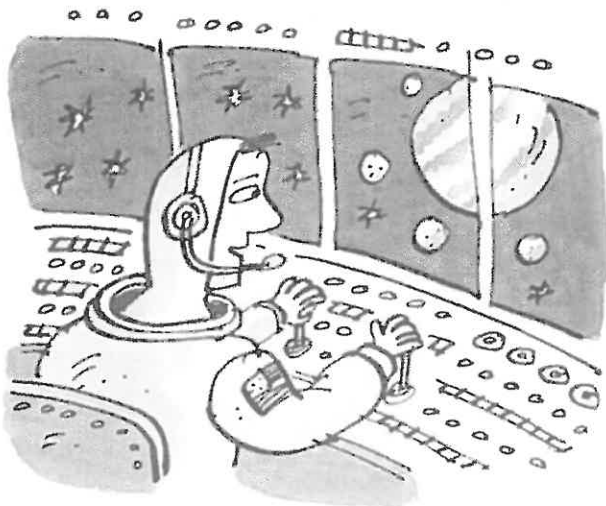
