

Hurricanes!

What is a hurricane?

A hurricane is a huge storm with strong winds and heavy rain. The centre of the storm is 'the eye' and it is the calmest part of the hurricane: it has only light winds. When hurricanes come to land, the heavy rain and strong winds can damage buildings, trees and cars.


Hurricanes have different names in different places.

- They call them 'hurricanes' in North America and the Caribbean.
- They call them 'cyclones' in the Indian Ocean.
- They call them 'typhoons' in Southeast Asia.

Where and when do hurricanes form?

Hurricanes form over warm waters near the equator. This is because there is a lot of warm water in these areas to allow the storms to form.

Hurricanes in the Caribbean and the Atlantic Ocean occur between June 1st and November 30th each year. This is the hurricane season.




