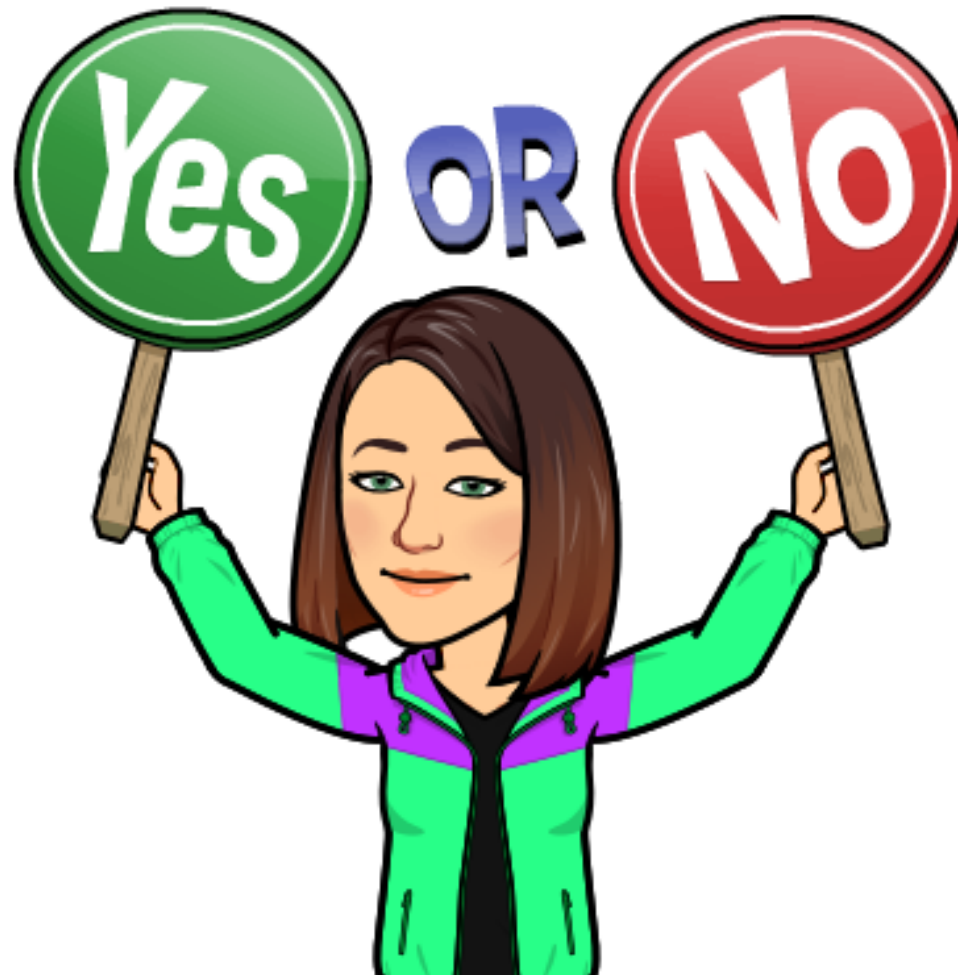

Do you help people? (*¿Ayudas a la gente?*)

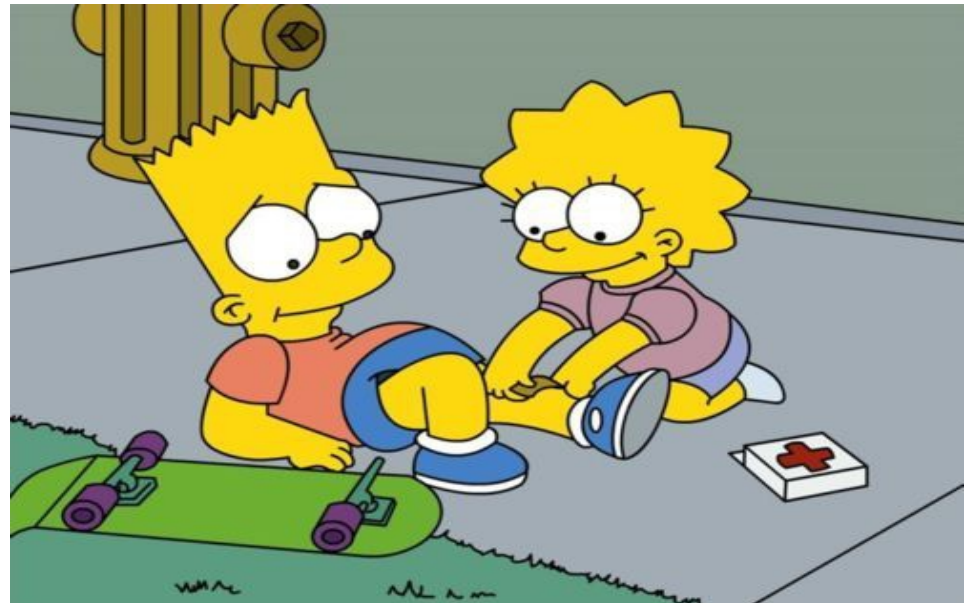
