1. Presentation.



Hi! I am Garfield. I live with Jon and Odie. I like eating and sleeping very much! I don't like mice!



This is Jon. He is Garfield's owner. He loves Garfield and Odie.



Hi! I am Odie. Garfield lives with us. He eats a lot and weighs 25 pounds! He doesn't like dieting.

Garfield likes to push me off the table but we can be good friends sometimes!

The Use:

We use The Present Simple for things that are true in general, or for things that happen sometimes or all the time:

Eg. Garfield likes eating very much!

Sometimes Garfield likes to push Odie off the table.

Garfield and Odie live with Jon.

Grammar-guide:

Spelling rules:

1. verbs ending in ss, sh, ch, x, o +S **+es**

I watch → he watches
I go → he goes

2. verbs ending in a consonant +Y **y - ies**

they cry → she cries
we try → he tries

Time phrases :

We often use the present simple with words that tell us how often: *often, always, never, seldom, sometimes, usually, once a day/a year, every day/year/month, all the time*.
