This is Jon. He is Garfield's owner. He loves Garfield and Odie.



Garfield <u>likes</u> to push me off the table but we can be good friends sometimes!



Hi! I am Odie.
Garfield <u>lives</u> with
us. He <u>eats</u> a lot
and <u>weighs</u> 25
pounds! He <u>doesn't</u>
<u>like</u> dieting.





We use The Present Simple for things that are <u>true in general</u>, or for <u>things that happen sometimes or all the time:</u>


Eg. Garfield likes eating very much!

**Sometimes** Garfield **likes** to push Odie off the table.

Garfield and Odie live with Jon.
