#### TOPIC: GREEN CITIES

You and Candidate A/B are attending a conference on the topic of **green cities** in which you have heard the three statements in the box below.

- Talk to each other about how these statements represent different ways of making cities more eco-friendly.
- Then decide together which of the statements best reflects the most relevant aspect when trying to make cities more eco-friendly.

- People often have to commute in cities. Solutions for transportation that let people get around easily and quickly without needing their own vehicle are one of the key elements to a city going green.
- Parks can be considered the lungs of cities. The trees in them clean the air and the parks themselves give the citizens a place where they can relax, take a deep breath and reconnect with nature. They also act as a cooling counterbalance to the heat created by all the concrete and asphalt.
- Cities need to support non-motorised transport modes such as cycling by creating and/or improving cycle lanes and road infrastructure, offering additional bicycle services like safe and comfortable parking, rental systems etc.
