

Parts of a Comic Book Page

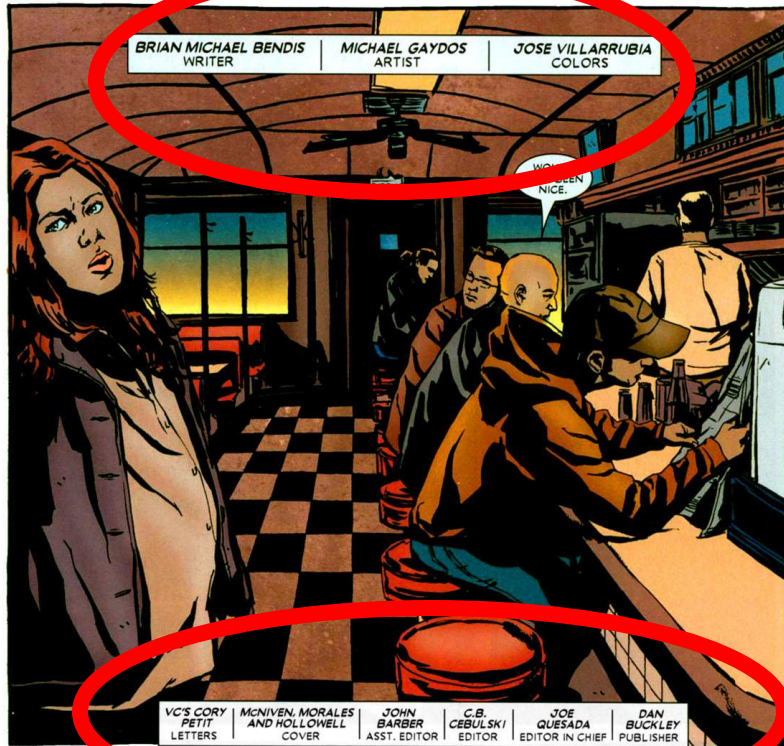
- *Panel* – One illustration in a square or rectangular frame. Sometimes in a circular or irregularly-shaped panel.
- *Gutter* - The space on a comic book page that is outside the panels.



- *Speech Balloons* – Contain what a character is saying. Usually round.
- *Thought Balloons* - Contain what a character is thinking. Usually has lumpy edges, like clouds.
- *Pointers* – Indicate which character is speaking.
- *Bubbles* – Indicate which character is thinking.



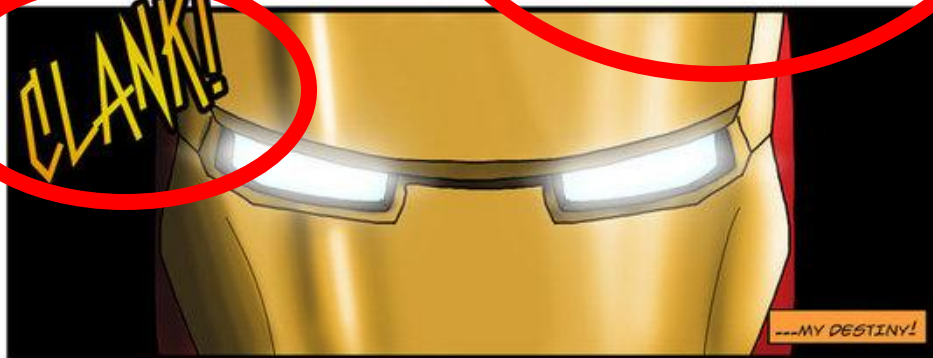
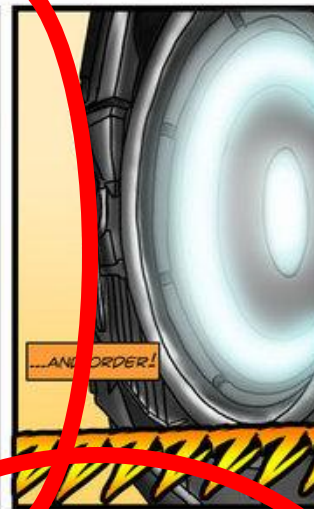
- *Title* - Name of the comic or story.
- *Credits* – Names of the writers and artists of the comic.



- *Captions* – Words that are not in speech or thought balloons. Usually in a square or rectangle.
- *Sound Effects* - Words that depict noises or sounds.
