
HOW TO WRITE A BLOG POST





STARTING A BLOG POST

TITLE

Short + interesting Eye-catching Make me want to keep reading

USER NAME

Posted by+nickname+on date+time Example, Blood is thicker than water Posted by: Susan Meyers on 23th Oct,

2018, 18:00pm

OPENING

The opening is just one paragraph which main purpose is to get the readers interested in with an anecdote, a question, an interesting fact, a quote, etc.



BODY

The body consists of 2 - 3 paragraphs, each one dealing with one aspect.

Remember a paragraph is not a sentence, there needs to be more:

- Topic sentence
- Supporting sentences that expand the idea (reasons, examples, references, etc.)
- Concluding sentence



CLOSING

The closing is one paragraph concluding the writer's opinion. Remember:

Do not introduce any new ideas. Do not write a very long one. Address the readers directly.







Optional: Include a final sentence encouraging people to contribute with their comments. Some expressions: Share your thoughts. / Let me know about what you think. / I'm looking forward to reading your thoughts.
