

Novel study_ Book in a bag

Choose and complete **six activities** based on the novel of your choice. After 3 weeks you will need to upload a picture of your paper bag novel study to the virtual classroom designed task. **IMPORTANT 3 of the activities must be under the codes CR, WR and CR/WR**

WR Write a scene that could have happened in the book, but did not.	CR Create a board or card game about the book. The game should include details about the setting, characters, and plot to show knowledge of the book. Include instructions about how to play	S Create a family tree for the characters in your novel	CR Make models of three objects which were important in the book you read. On a card attached to each model, tell why that object was important in the book.	WR Write a letter to the author of the book. Explain why you like the story.	CR Design and make your own t-shirt. Illustrate a scene or character from the book on a t-shirt.
S Make a crossword or find-a-word using words from the book	WR/SP Make a pretend interview with a character- make up questions to ask and act it out with a partner. Recorded and upload the file.	WR Pretending you are a character in the book. Write a letter or an email to another character (minimum 3 paragraphs 80 words)	WR Write a character description of someone in the story (minimum 2 paragraph). Illustrate it.	WR Write a diary entry that a main character might have written (minimum 3 paragraphs 80 words)	CR Make a doll, puppet.
CR/WR Create a newspaper for your book. Summarize the plot in one article, cover the weather in another, do a feature story on one of the more interesting characters in another. Include an editorial and a collection of ads that would be pertinent to the story.	S Make a list or a timeline of the main events in the story in order.	CR Choose a paragraph that you liked. Copy it and illustrate it. Include the page reference paragraph.	CR/WR Design a book cover for the book. Include a blurb for the back.	CR/WR Choose an event or situation and make a comic strip of the characters and their conversation.	CR/WR Prepare a travel brochure for a book. Create a colorful brochure based on the setting of your book. Give reasons people should want to visit this location. Describe what occurred in this location in the book.
CR Make a poster to promote the book	Free choice activity	CR Create a diorama of a scene from the book. Create a scene from the book in a shoebox.	CR Create bookmarks	WR Write a new charter saying what might happened after the end of the book.	CR/WR Make 3 drawings of important scenes from the book. Drawings should be colored. Write a description of what each scene is and why it is important.
