- To go bust: To spend or lose all of one's money. To go broke. - Ir a la ruina, quebrar.
- To rely on (sthg) (sbdy) [intransitive ph. verb]: To put trust in. - Confiar en.
- Bale (n): A large bundle, especially one tied tightly. - Fardo.
- Overflowing (adj): To have the contents flowing or spilling over an edge, rim, etc. - Rebosante
- Landfill (n): A low area of land built up from deposits of solid garbage in layers and covered by soil. - Vertedero.
- Cast off (sthg) / Cast (sthg) off [transitive ph. verb]: To throw away, reject. - Deshacerse de, desprenderse de.
- Fabric (n) [False Friend]: A cloth made by weaving or knitting threads or fibers. - Tejido.
- UN Goodwill Ambassador: A honorific title that is assigned to a person who advocates for a specific cause or global issue on the basis of their notability such as a public figure, advocate or an authoritative expert. - Embajador /-a de buena voluntad de la ONU.
- Waterway (n): A body of water serving as a means for ships to travel. - Canal. (No vídeo refirese más a unha vía de auga (?))
- To choke (v): To stop the breath of someone by squeezing or blocking the windpipe; strangle. - Asfixiar.
- To commit (v): To obligate (oneself), such as by a pledge. - Comprometer(se).
- To dispose (v): To get rid of; discard or destroy. - Deshacerse de.
- To cope (with) (sthg) / (sbdy) [intransitive ph. Verb]: To struggle or deal, especially on fairly even terms of with some degree of success. - Lidar con.
