

# SPEAKING TERM 2 – Important Female Figures

You will work **in groups** to research an important female figure and present her life and achievements to the class.

## You must prepare:

- A short written text
- A poster
- An oral presentation (5–7 minutes per group)

## Step 1: Choose a Female Figure

Choose one important woman from history, science, culture, sports, politics, or activism. All group members must agree on the same person.

## Step 2: Written Text (120–150 words)

Your text must include:

- Basic information (birth, background)
- Important achievements
- Why she is important
- Your group's opinion

## YOU MUST USE

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Present tenses (present simple / present continuous)</li><li>• Past tenses</li><li>• At least ONE passive sentence</li><li>• Modals (can, must, should, etc.)</li><li>• Relative clauses (who, which, that)</li><li>• At least ONE future sentence</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Any vocabulary from all units that might be useful.</li><li>• Vocabulary of your own.</li></ul>

## Step 3: Poster

- Title (name of the woman)
- At least **4 pictures**
- Short texts or bullet points
- Clear and organised design
- No copied text from the internet

## Step 4: Oral Presentation

- 5–7 minutes per group
- All students must speak
- You may use notes, but do NOT read
- Speak clearly and look at the audience
