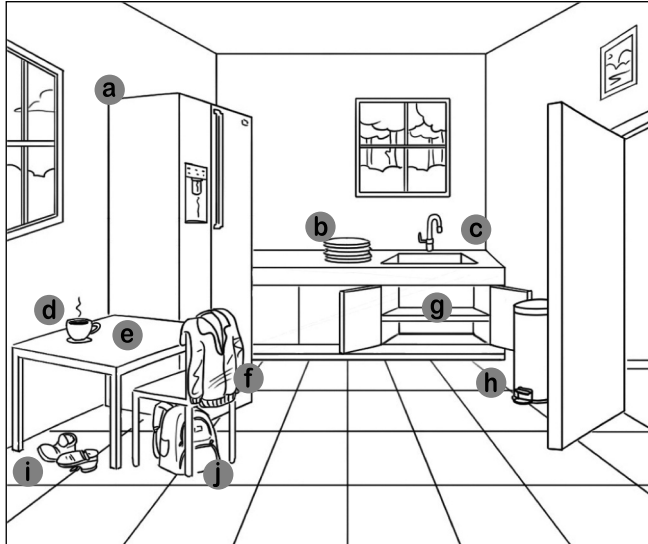

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### Zao Onsen: Japan

This year, my family and I are at Zao Onsen in Japan – a great place for skiing and snowboarding. There are many places to ski and some good hotels here. But many people travel to this place every year for another reason, too. Zao Onsen, in the Yamagata area in the north west of Japan, is also home to a forest. This forest is beautiful all year round. But for about four months, you can see the *juhyo* effect. There are many snowstorms and the whole forest becomes white. The trees look like monsters from a science-fiction film – it's amazing! The *juhyo* effect begins in December and disappears in March when the spring comes.

This is a traditional Japanese bed. Then, in the morning, we have *tsukemono* – Japanese vegetables – with rice and miso soup for breakfast. This afternoon, we plan to visit a Japanese bathhouse outside. It's got natural hot water from the mountains with temperatures of about 45°C. It's another reason to choose Zao Onsen.
