Expresiones

- Se usa el Present Perfect con expresiones de tiempo no terminadas.
- Ejemplos:
 - Mr. Piña has received a few emails this morning.
 - Mark has seen Morgan twice today.
 - We've had an English test this week.
 - So far they have scored two goals.



Just, Already, Yet

- **Just:** Used for recently completed actions.
 - I've just seen Mitch in front of the door.
 - Anna's just been to visit her grandparents.
- **Already:** Indicates something happened before now.
 - I've already started saving money for my holiday.
- **Yet:** Used in questions and negatives.
 - Have you done your homework yet?
 - Sandra hasn't tidied her flat yet.



Experiencias

- **Ever** se usa para preguntar por experiencias en la vida.
- **Never** se usa para negar experiencias.
- Ejemplo: Have you ever been to the US?
- Ejemplo: I've never seen an elephant.



For y Since

- **For** + período de tiempo (una semana, un mes, un año)
- **Since** + punto en el tiempo específico
- Ejemplos:
 - They've lived there **for** three years.
 - Peter has been on holiday **for** three days.
 - I have worked here **since** January last year.
 - Phillips hasn't heard from his friend **since** last month.
