

PENSAR-REFLEXIONAR: (25:35-27:10)

“... actually every human being as a thinking being can reflect as well as I do, and can therefore judge for himself, if he wants to. How I can arouse this wish in him, this I don't know. The only thing which can help us, I think, is really to *réfléchir*. And to think always means to think critically. And to think critically is always to be hostile. Every thought actually undermines whatever there is of rigid rules, general convictions, etc. Every thing which happens in thinking is subject to a critical examination, of whatever there is. That is, there are no dangerous thoughts, for the simple reason that thinking itself is such a dangerous enterprise. ... I think non-thinking is even more dangerous. I don't deny that thinking is dangerous. But, I would say, not thinking is even more dangerous.”
