ZERO CONDITIONAL

If + Present Simple, Present Simple

Use General truths, facts, or things that are *always true*

Example →

If you heat water, it boils.
If it rains, the grass gets wet.



FIRST CONDITIONAL

If + Present Simple, will + base verb

Use Real and possible future situations

Example →

If it rains tomorrow, I'll stay
at home.
If you study, you will pass.



SECOND CONDITIONAL

If + Past Simple, would + base verb

Use Unreal, imaginary, or unlikely situations
(present/future)

Example →

If I had a car, I would drive
to work.
If it were sunny, we would go out.

Zero Conditional → If + Present, Present → FACTS

First Conditional → If + Present, WILL + Verb → POSSIBLE FUTURE

Second Conditional → If + PAST, WOULD + Verb → IMAGINARY / UNREAL

With the second conditional, the result is almost impossible. Possible but very very very improbable.

If I had a lot of money

If I won the lottery

If I met

A common way to give an advice is Eng is If I were you... (2nd condit is also for situations that are impossible)*

If I didn't have children... I would travel more. (not possible bc I have children)
