

FUTURE CONTINUOUS

Lo usamos para:

1. Expresar una acción que estará en progreso en un momento específico del futuro.
Ejemplo: "Tomorrow at 10 am I will be having breakfast".
2. Expresar planes futuros. Ejemplo "In two years, I will be studying Psychology at Uni!".

Normalmente va acompañado de expresiones como "at this time tomorrow", "soon", "on Monday...", "in the next decade", "In 5 years time..."

Traducción: "estaré haciendo". In 5 years I **will be working**. - En 5 años **estaré trabajando**.

Estructura: Will be + v-ing / won't be + v-ing / will + subj + be + v-ing...? Examples: I will be traveling the world / They won't be living in Vigo / Will she be working with her family?

To remember: think about a picture that comes from the future. To describe that picture you have to use future continuous!

FUTURE PERFECT SIMPLE

Lo usamos para:

- Expresar una acción que ya estará terminada en un momento específico del futuro. Suele ir acompañado de expresiones como "By this time next year", "by 2 o'clock", "by the end of ...", "in five months...".
Ejemplo: "By 4 pm, I will have arrived home"

Traducción: "haber hecho". By 2027, you will have finished bachillerato - en 2027, ya habréis terminado bachillerato.

Estructura:

- Will + have + past participle (-ed / 3ª columna de los verbos irregulares). By the end of the month, I will have read 4 books.
- Won't + have + past participle: By 6 pm, she won't have arrived home. She's got dancing lessons.
- Will + subject + have + past participle...? Will they have finished their homework by tomorrow?
