



PRESENT SIMPLE VS. CONTINUOUS

SIMPLE —————> ROUTINES

- Affirmative: Subject + **vb**(s) + Complements
- Negative: Subject + don't / doesn't + **vb** + Complements
- Question: Do / Does + Subject + **vb** + complements?





PRESENT SIMPLE VS. CONTINUOUS

CONTINUOUS → NOW - EXCEPTION

- Affirmative: Subject + **am/is/are** + **vb-ing** + Complements
- Negative: Subject + **am not/isn't/aren't** + **vb-ing** + Complements
- Question: **am/is/are** + Subject + **vb-ing** + complements?
