



Finished past actions

- Affirmative: Subject + **vb -ed/2nd column** + Complements
- Negative: Subject + **didn't** + **vb** + Complements
- Question: **Did** + **vb** + complements?



# PRESENT PERFECT

PAST  PRESENT

**KEY WORDS**  
already, just,  
yet, for,  
since.  
EVER

- Affirmative: Subject + HAVE/HAS + p.participle (-ed/3rd column) + Complements
- Negative: Subject + HAVEN'T/HASN'T + p.participle (-ed/3rd column) + Complements
- Question: HAVE/HAS + subject + p.participle (-ed/3rd c) + Complements?



Predictions - Promises - Decisions while speaking - Small probability

- Affirmative: Subject + **will** + **vb** + complements.
- Negative: Subject + **won't** + **vb** + complements
- Question: **Will** + Subject + **vb** + complements?

# FUTURE. BE GOING TO

Plans - general intentions

- Affirmative: Subject + **am/is/are** + **going to** + **vb** + complements.
- Negative: Subject + **am not/isn't/aren't** + **going to** + **vb** + complements
- Question: **am/is/are** + Subject + **going to** + **vb** + complements?





# FUTURE. PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Definite arrangements

- Affirmative: Subject + **am/is/are** + **vb-ing** + Complements
- Negative: Subject + **am not/isn't/aren't** + **vb-ing** + Complements
- Question: **am/is/are** + Subject + **vb-ing** + complements?




