



- Negative: Subject + **didn't** + **vb** + Complements
- Question: **Did** + **vb** + complements?



PAST CONTINUOUS


Actions that were in progress in at a particular moment in the past



PAST CONTINUOUS

Actions that started in the past and continued for a period of time.

- Affirmative: Subject + **was/were** + **vb-ing** Complements
- Negative: Subject + **wasn't/weren't** + **vb-ing** + Complements
- Question: **was/were** + Subject + **vb-ing** + complements?



PAST SIMPLE VS PAST CONTINUOUS

We often use the p.simple and past continuous together to say that something happened in the middle of something else:



I had a hamburger while John was running
