REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

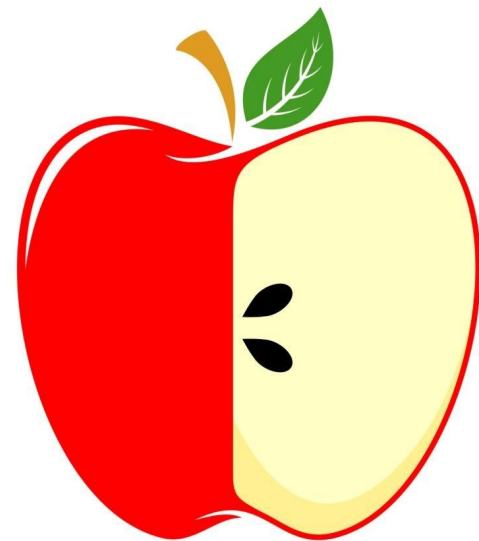
- Myself**
- Yourself**

1. SUBJECT = OBJECT

The reflexive pronouns show that the subject and the object of the verb are the same person. When the person doing the action is also the person receiving the action.

EXAMPLE

I CUT AN APPLE



BUT

I CUT MYSELF



They look at **themselves** in the mirror



They look at **them** at the mirror



I cut **me**.

I cut **myself**.

She blamed **her**.

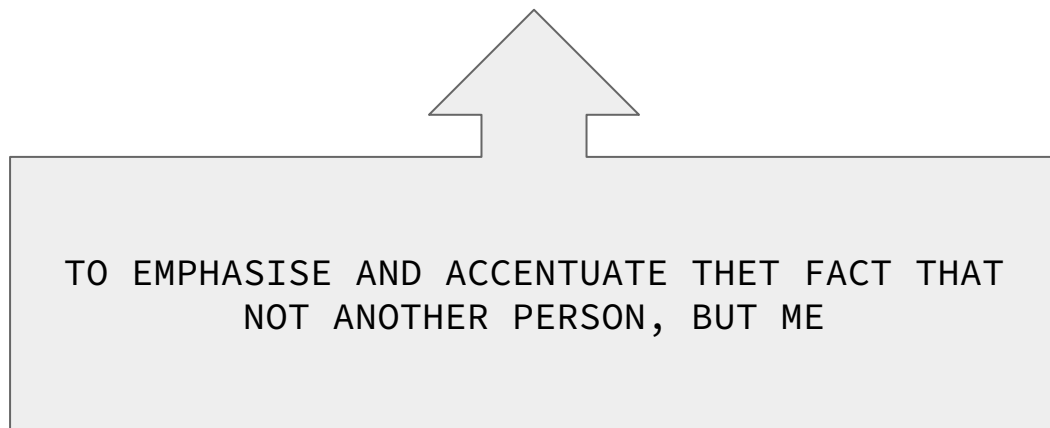
She blamed **herself**.

themselves in the mirror.


2. ADD EMPHASIS

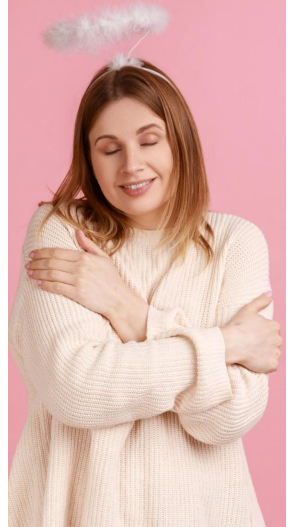

themselves
