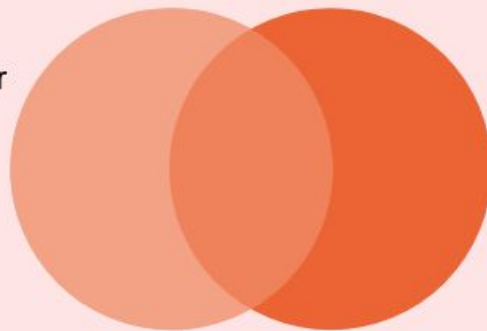


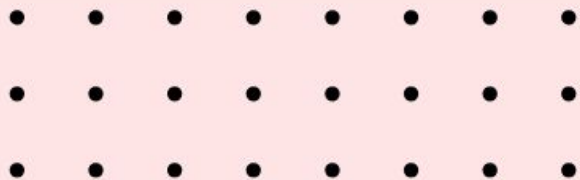
Passive Voice

- The focus is on the results, not the person



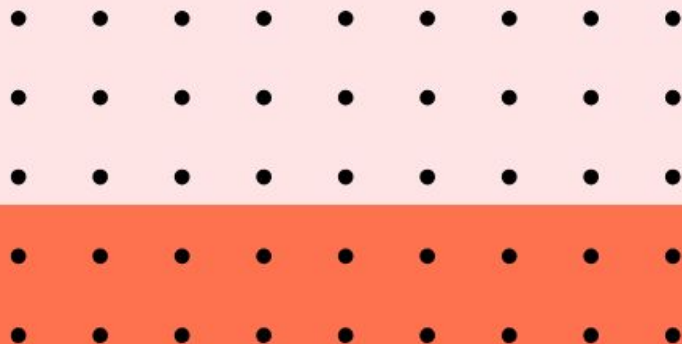


Examples

The road is being repaired

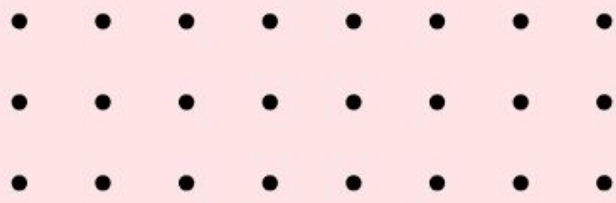
A new law has been introduced

SUBJECT + 'BE' + PAST PARTICIPLE

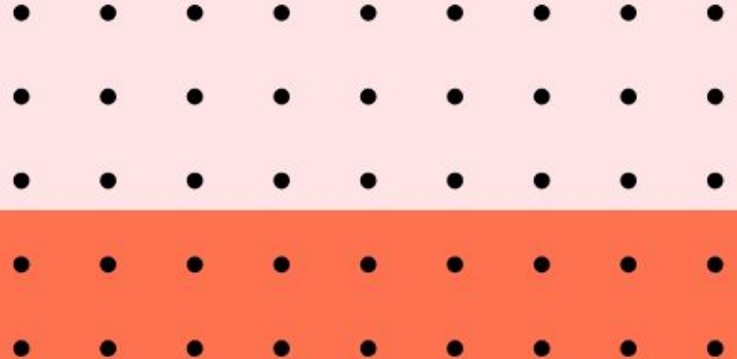




Present Simple

The postman **delivers** the letters every morning.



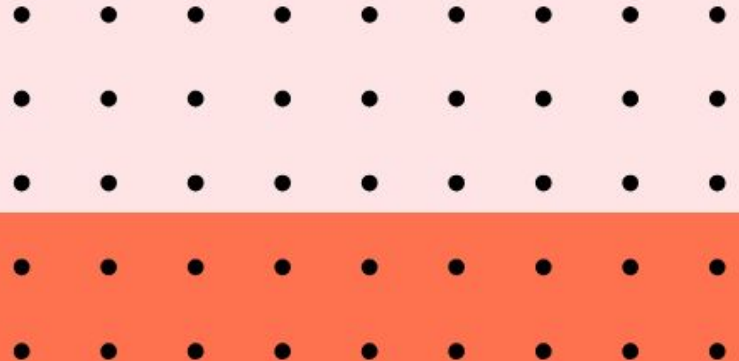
