

How to write a short story/Tale



- You need an idea
- Start as close to end as possible.
- Keep the number of characters small.
- Create conflict
- Appeal to the 5 senses
- It should have pictures.

How to write an informative text



- It includes pictures, timelines, glossary, etc to help the reader find information.
- Conduct good research. This is very important for an informative essay. You need to have accurate information. Be very careful to use objective sources written by experts on your topic. You must have a bibliography at the end of your essay.
- Take notes as you research. Write interesting facts that you read. Keep all your notes for the essay in one place.
- You need an introduction, at least three main points, and a conclusion. You may want to make these sections and write notes down under the section where you expect it to go.
