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We are working on:

- ▶ **Assessment procedures:** observation of the work and participation of the students in the face-to-face session will comprise up to 30% of the grade.
- ▶ **Instruments of evaluation:**
 - ▶ Carrying out a reflective **written test in each evaluation** that will involve up to 50% of the grade in the 1st and 2nd terms.
 - ▶ **Presentations** delivered individually or in small groups by students: up to 30% of the grade in the 1st and 2nd terms.
 - ▶ **Final report** describing the process of design and development of a project of individual or small group research, applying the knowledge gained in the analysis of the socioeconomic reality of the environment: up to 80% of the grade in the 3rd term.



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We are working with:

► Collaborative work:

- Analysis of advertising, documentary films, and plot (short and medium-length films).
- Group reflections based on reading press articles and narratives.

► Research with:

- Secondary sources (bibliography available in the library, the Network)
- Primary sources (interviews with people and testimonials already available in archives).

► Conversation & Debates with our Language Assistant.
