
A Description of a Place

Useful vocabulary to recreate the atmosphere:

- Location: on the coast, inland, by a lake/river, in the mountains/hills, near downtown, in the suburbs, ...
- <u>Sight</u>: colourful, bright, huge, tiny, long, wide, narrow, ...
- <u>Smell</u>: fresh, clean, sweet, polluted ...
- Hearing: noisy, quiet, silent, rumble, splashing, ...
- <u>General</u>: peaceful, hectic, stunning, picturesque, crowded, empty, lively, happening, unspoilt, breathtaking, ...
