B) Double comparatives

They describe a cause and effect process, a proportionate increase or decrease. We use the double comparative to say when something increases or decreases it causes something else to change.

-The more... the more

The more you study, the more you learn.

The more money he makes, the more expensive things he buys.

-The more... the less

The more I read, the less I remember.

The more I worry, the less I sleep.

-The less... the more

The less he sees people, the more isolated he becomes.

The less you exercise, the more weight you put on.

We can make comparisons using adjectives, adverbs and nouns.

- -The older we grow, the wiser we become.
- -The younger you learn a language, the easier it is.
- **-The more carefully** you plan your trip, the better the result will be.
