EASILY CONFUSED WORDS

THEORY:

The words live and alive are easily confused.

Examples:

1) Live /'laiv/ is an adjective or an adverb:

We saw a live performance (adjective)

They enjoy playing live (adverb)

2) Alive /a'laiv/ is an adjective:

You are lucky to be alive!

3) Live /liv/ is a verb:

We live in Valencia.
