

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

subject	+ am/are/is	+ verb- <i>ing</i>
I	'm / am	painting . Sorry about the mess.
You	're / are	watching TV.
He	's / is	sleeping at the moment.
She	's / is	playing golf with her friends.
It	's / is	snowing .
We	're / are	working right now.
You	're / are	eating dinner in the kitchen.
They	're / are	practising for the concert.

Negative -

subject	+ am not/ aren't/ isn't	or	+ verb- <i>ing</i>
I	am not	I'm not	working right now.
You	aren't / are not	You're not	living in England at moment.
He	isn't / is not	He's not	baking a cake today.
She	isn't / is not	She's not	feeling well at the moment.
It	isn't / is not	It's not	raining . Let's go for a walk.
We	aren't / are not	We're not	playing football.
You	aren't / are not	You're not	brushing your teeth properly.
They	aren't / are not	They're not	waiting for me.
