Reading

Hundreds of students in Australia live a long way from towns and they haven't got schools near them. Where do they study? At home – with their telephone and computer. Their teachers send schoolwork to them on the Internet. Then the students work at home and e-mail the work to their teachers at school. Teachers sometimes talk to their students on the telephone, too. Students learn maths, English, science, history, geography and many other subjects.




