**Job Summary:** Responds to emergency calls. Assesses, treats and provides efficient and immediate care to the ill and injured and continues first aid en route to medical facility. Drives ambulances, washes them, completes reports and assists the Physician or Registered Nurse. Flexible with work schedules and available for call. S/he works different shift, different days of the week, holidays, weekends, or as assigned.

### Qualifications required

- High School Diploma as EMT.
- Must complete all EMS department training and orientation requirements within the initial employment period.
- Independent or proficient user of English (B2, C1).

### Job Requirements

- One year of minimum work experience as an Emergency Medical Technician.
- Required Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities: ability to use good judgment and common sense; leadership ability and ability to interact with minimal supervision; ability to interact with patients, hospital personnel, and the general public. Good communication skills as well as clinical skills.
- Must be 18 or older.

### Physical Requirements

Must have a perfect sense of sight, hearing, smell and touch. Heavy lifting is required to load and unload patients and carry equipment. Work requires standing, sitting, bending, pulling, pushing, transporting and driving.
