## 1. PAINOFREE CAPSULES - EXP 02/28

Fast relief for headache, muscle pain, backache, toothache and fever.

### DOSAGE

Adults and children over 12: Take 1 capsule every 6–8 hours if necessary.

Do not take more than 4 capsules in any 24-hour period.

Not suitable for children under 12.

### WARNINGS

Do not take on an empty stomach.

Do not take with other painkillers unless advised by a doctor.

### SIDE-EFFECTS

May cause nausea, stomach pain or dizziness.

In rare cases, may cause allergic reactions or palpitations.

## 2. EYECALM DROPS - EXP 03/28

Hydrating eye drops for dry eyes, red eyes and irritation caused by screen use or dust.

### DOSAGE

Adults and children over 10: Apply 2 drops in each eye up to 3 times a day.

Children under 10: Use only on medical advice

### WARNINGS

Remove contact lenses before use.

Do not share this product with other people.

### SIDE-EFFECTS

May cause temporary blurred vision or mild burning in the eyes.

## 3. SUNPROTECT LOTION SPF 50 - EXP 24M

High protection sunscreen for sensitive skin. Helps protect against sunburn and skin damage caused by UV rays.

### DOSAGE

Reapply every 2 hours, especially after swimming or sweating.

### WARNINGS

Avoid contact with eyes.

Keep babies and young children out of direct sunlight.

### SIDE-EFFECTS

May cause mild skin irritation or redness in sensitive skin.

Stop using the product if a rash develops.
