PAST SIMPLE REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS

REMEMBER – COPIA ESTO EN TU LIBRETA

En el pasado simple hay verbos regulares (played, watched, listened, etc) y verbos irregulares (drank, sank, put, set, etc.).

- **En frases afirmativas** seguimos el esquema:

Sujeto + verbo en pasado + Complementos > **Yesterday I played football or I sent an email to my friend last week.**

- **En frases negativas** seguimos el esquema: Sujeto + didn't (did + not) + verbo EN INFINITIVO + Complementos > **Yesterday I didn't play football or I didn't send an email to my friend last week.**
- **En frases interrogativas** seguimos el esquema: (Wh-) + Did + Sujeto + Verbo EN INFINITIVO + Complementos? > **Where did you play football yesterday? Or Did you play football yesterday?**

En pasado simple usamos expresiones de tiempo como: **yesterday (ayer)**, **last week (la semana pasada)**, **last month (el mes pasado)**, **10 minutes ago (hace 10 minutos)**, **2 years ago (hace dos años)**, **last summer (el verano pasado)**, **in 1999 (en 1999)**, **last Christmas (las navidades pasadas)**, etc.
