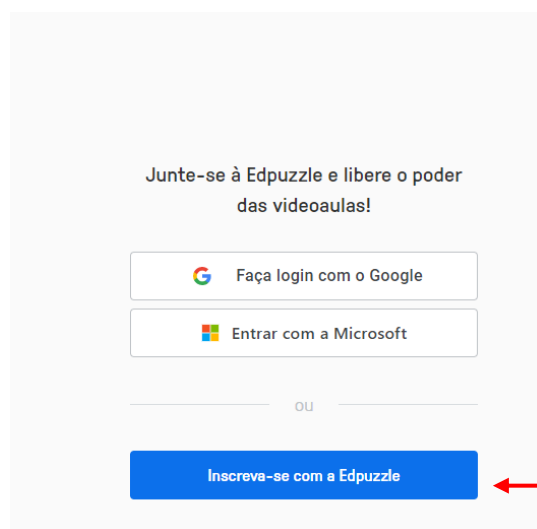
What is EdPuzzle

Edpuzzle is an easy-to-use platform allowing you to engage every student, one video at a time. Get to know more about us below.

Edpuzzle is an online video editing and formative assessment tool that lets teachers cut, crop, and organize videos. But it does so much more, too. Unlike a traditional video editor, this is more about getting clips into a format that allows teachers to engage directly with students on a subject.

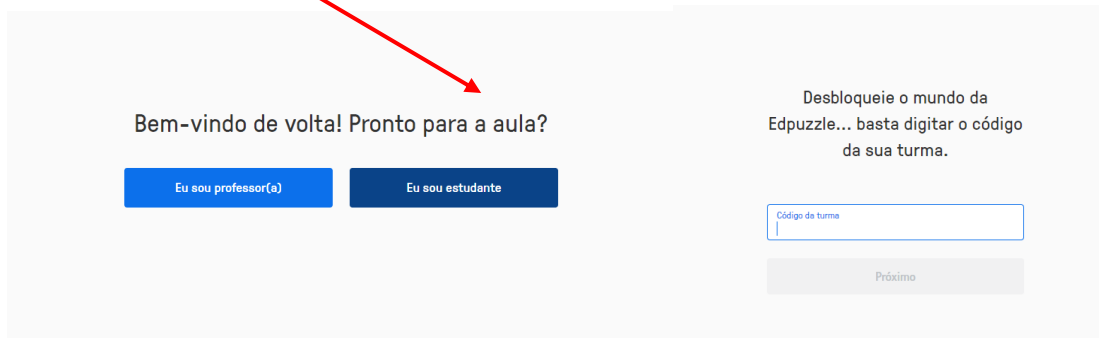
This guide aims to help parents and students register on this platform, whenever requested by the teacher.

To login to the page, if it is the first time you have to register:



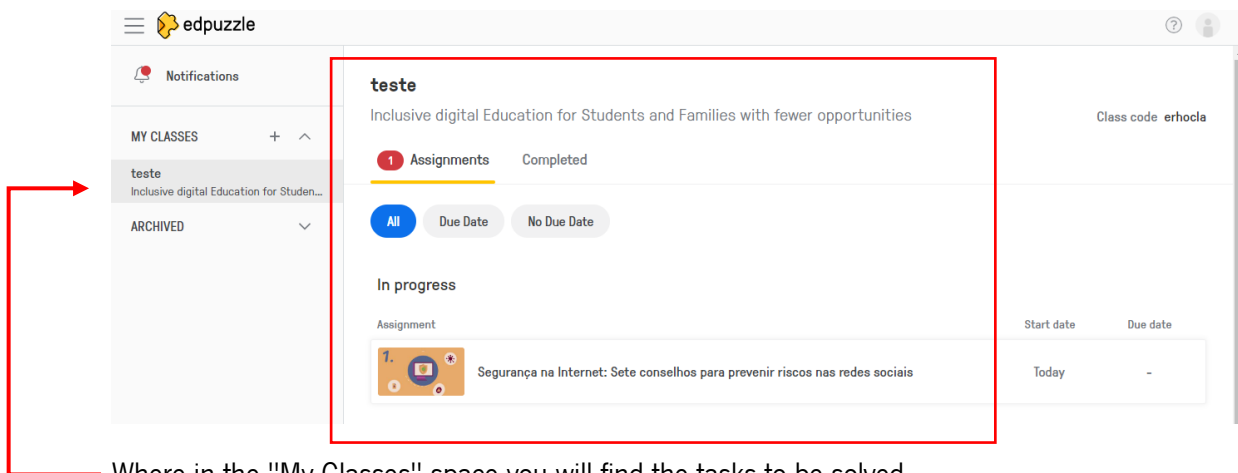
The registration is done either through a school Office or Google account, or in case you have been asked by the teacher to enter a specific class you have to click on the "Sign up with EdPuzzle" option

If you register with your school account you have to identify yourself as a student or teacher, in your case as a student.:



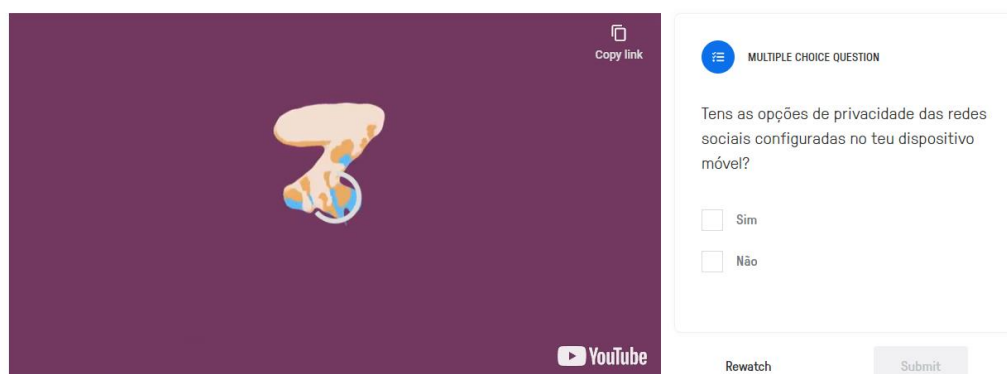
And enter the class code provided by the teacher

After entering the space provided by the teacher, your work area is like the one you find here:



Where in the "My Classes" space you will find the tasks to be solved.

This specific tool, as mentioned before, aims to watch a video provided by the teacher and watch it to the end answering the questions that are being asked while watching the video

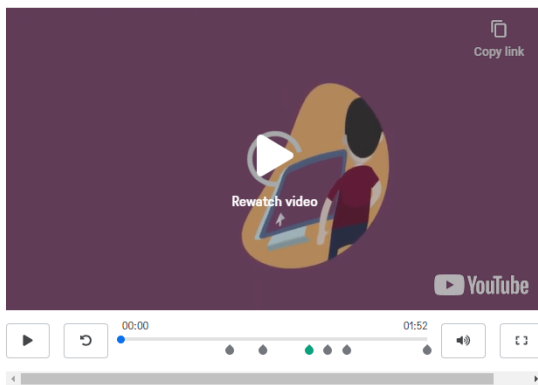
